

MARKET UPDATE

We hope that our mild winter is treating you well and that you and your family are busy getting into the holiday spirit with fun filled memories. At this time of the year, we often reflect on the year past and make plans for the future. A time of love, laughter and giving.

The year is not over yet, so let's see what is happening in our local real estate market. In the South Okanagan, 133 properties were listed in the month of November, which is down 51.64% from November of last year.

Year to date, however, listing inventory is up 0.73% over last year. 38 properties traded hands in our region last month, which is down a whopping 64.49% compared to November of last year. Year to date 1542 unit sales have been reported which is down 20.31% from the same time period last year.

Many would-be buyers and sellers have shelved their plans for this year in favour of the Spring of 2024. The average sale price for all types of real estate has decreased by 3.86% year to date to \$695,649 and the average sale price for single-family homes decreased by 2.13% year to date to \$809,578.

In the City of Penticton, 67 properties were listed last month, which is down 55.92% from November of last

year. Year to date there have been 1548 new listings hit the system in Penticton which is down 2.82% from last year. It was quiet as far as real estate sales activity in Penticton, with only 15 sales reported which is down 68% from the 47 reported last November. Year to date there have been 798 properties trade hands which is down 17% from the 846 sales that were reported last year. The average sale price for all types of real estate has decreased by less than a percent year to date to \$666,566, as well as the average sale price for single family decreased by 2.77% to \$859,684.

Average Days on Market in Penticton



Who is the Okanagan Buyer?


Q3 2023 YTD






Average Sale Price Single Family YTD Comparison In Penticton

5 Year Comparison of YTD Unit Sales & Listings




What are They Buying in the Okanagan?
